When you register you are liable for full tuition until May 31, 2020 unless you withdraw **IN WRITING 2 weeks in advance**. Class payments are due **before** the first of each month. There is a grace period the first week of classes. After the first week of classes the account is past due and a monthly late fee of \$20 will be applied. Returned check fee is \$30.

Accounts 30 days past due will be suspended and you WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN CLASS UNTIL THE ACCOUNT IS CURRENT.

Skipping a month is not allowed. If you stop you will need to re-register and pay the registration fee. Make up classes **CANNOT** be used in lieu of payment or after students withdraw. Make up classes are available at Spendwood discretion and are only good for one month after the missed class. You must have a permission slip from the desk and there are no make-up's for Spendwood holidays. **NO refunds.**

Waiver of Liability: It is important that students and families understand that there is risk of injury in dance, tumbling, gymnastics and exercise classes. By registering you agree to save and hold harmless Spendwood School of Dance &

Gymnastics, its teachers, employees and agents. They will not be held responsible for injury to person or property while participating in Spendwood classes or activities. 2019/20 Student Handbook

Welcome to Spendwood, 55 years of quality, caring Instruction in Cohoes. Join us as we go for 56!!

Here is your 2019/20 student handbook, with the information you need to get started and our policies and procedures. Here you will find important dates, activities, tuition, dress codes and basic information for dance and gymnastics.

Our school year runs September—May. We will also provide a June Gymnastics program and a 6 week Summer Camp and Summer Class schedule for those interested. When you register you are enrolled and obligated to pay the full monthly tuition until the end of May or you withdraw in Writing, in advance. You must complete the current month and will then be dropped as of the first of the next month. Make-up classes cannot be used in lieu of monthly payments.

2019/20 classes will begin on Monday September 9th. We carefully select the best class for your age and level, and we are very specific about level. For this reason we do not publish our full class schedule. We generally have several class options in order to provide you with a schedule to best fit your needs. The non-refundable annual registration fee secures your place in class and helps us set up the class schedule.

Fun learning is our goal. While safety comes first, every student is important. Our job is to help the students gain new skills and abilities, gain new knowledge and have fun! Students flourish gaining self confidence and self esteem.

2019/20 TUITION

1. **Annual registration fee** \$30. Our School year is September—May. Upon registration you are enrolled until May 31st of the current year.
2. Tuition may be paid on a monthly basis. If you stop you must withdraw in writing or you will be charged until May 31st. If you stop mid-year you will need to register again to resume classes.
3. **Tuition is due** by the first of the month. **On the 7th a \$20 late fee per month** will be assessed. For accounts 30 days past due, class participation will be suspended until all tuition is paid.

NO refunds for tuition, registrations, deposits or costumes. Make up classes are only good for one month after the missed class and CANNOT be used in lieu of payment or after students withdraw.

Be a part of something very special and know that you are giving others the gift of love through dance. **Try-outs will be at the studio on Saturday September 21st. All practices will be on Saturdays.**

Come and join the fun! The show is open to all ages five and up. There will be tap, jazz, ballet, hip-hop and more. If you are in the show the class/music/costume fee for all 10 weeks is \$75.

Annual Dance Recital

This is a very special opportunity for ALL dance students to perform live on stage for a large audience of friends and family. This includes Mommy & Me students and parents. To be part of a major production is fun and exciting and a true lifetime experience. The recital is optional, however most children do want to participate.

Dance Dress Code

All dancers must be in dancewear. **No** jeans, street clothes or street shoes will be allowed. Leotard and Tights should be worn to every class. Dance pants or dance shorts can be worn over your leotard.

DANCE RECITAL COSTUMES

All dance costumes must be ordered in January in order to be here for the recital in June. A \$50 deposit will be posted to ALL dance students in December. You may opt out in writing only by December 14th. Full-payment is due by January 13th. Late fees will be added after January. Costume Prices are **per individual** student:

- A deposit is due in December and full payment in January. Costume payments are NON-REFUNDABLE. After January there will be a \$15 special order fee and we cannot guarantee they will be here in time.
- Costume deposits and payments are NON-refundable.
- First Costume \$78 (includes a finale T-Shirt)
- Additional Costumes (for same student) are \$65
- Additional T-Shirts may be ordered in advance for \$18
- The T-shirt will be worn in the recital finale & Waterford Canalfest.

GYMNASTIC INFORMATION

There is a year end In-House Gymnastics meet. This includes ALL gymnastics students, including Mommy & Me. A \$25 fee will be billed in April. Students may opt out of the meet IN WRITING by April 13th. Professional photo's of students will be taken during classes in March.

GYM DRESS CODE

Gymnasts may wear a leotard, gym shorts and/or footless tights with the leotard and bare feet. No baggy clothing and no shorts with buckles or zippers (they catch on the equipment) will be allowed. For your convenience these items are for sale in our store. Hair should be pulled back neatly and no jewelry worn during classes. This is for the safety of the gymnast.
